### The Numbers

As of 4-14-20



Our Intake Target: 413 new members

Our Actual: 210 new members (50.85% of goal)

Our Net Target: 261 new members

Our Actual: 141 new members (53.94% of goal)

Our Star Council Target: 16 Star Councils (out of 85)

Our Actual: 5 councils have reached or exceeded their new member goals

Our Actual: 3 more councils have reached at least 75% their new member goals

Our Actual: 11 councils only need 1 or 2 more new members to reach their new member goals

Our Actual: 3 councils have reached or exceeded their insurance goals

Our Actual: 3 more councils have reached 67% or more of their insurance goals

Our Actual: 41 councils have 0% new member growth

11 of these councils have net negative new member growth

Our Actual: 33 councils have not recruited a new member this year

As of Feb 29 we have 34 new online members so far this year.

Our goal this year is to again recruit at least 10% of our new members with this program. 34 of 194 is 17.5%

# Incentive Update
