Working with Your Pastor

Communicate with:

Use the Rule of 7

In Brief:

Have you ever struggled to have a good relationship with your pastor? Do you sometimes feel like you've tried everything but you and he don't see things eye to eye?

Consider the fact that this may be as simple as not understanding each other's intentions compounded by not communicating in ways that are mutually clear and beneficial.

Knights of Columbus councils are to be in service to the pastor and thereby the parish. While you may know this, has this been expressed (consistently) to your pastor?

Much like yourself, the pastor is extremely busy and in most cases he is being pulled in countless directions. He doesn't need more work, he needs more help. Who better than the Knights of Columbus to be in direct service to him?

In order for him to believe this, he must first trust and be able to depend on you and your council. While your words are important, a solid relationship with your pastor will be developed and sustained by your actions as a council. The response to your pastor's request for assistance must be an enthusiastic "yes."

Take Action:

Request to meet with your pastor and explain to him that your council's primary purpose is to be in service to him and the parish.

This needs to be expressed (and more importantly shown) repeatedly & consistently. If not, everything else you try to accomplish at the parish will be a struggle.

Help him to understand what your council can offer to the parish!

If a pastor doesn't want to engage with your council, it's often because he doesn't understand what you can offer or he has had bad experiences in the past. Most pastors will have preconceived ideas of the Knights (good and bad).

Explain and show your pastor the new Faith in Action program model. Find opportunities to sit down with him and discuss Faith in Action.

He may be pleasantly surprised that many (if not all) of the programs will directly serve the parish.

Rule of Seven







GENERAL RECRUITING BEST PRACTICES

Start with why.

Recruiting is our opportunity to build our brotherhood and help our communities. To grow is to be able to expand your service. Your community needs your council now more than ever and your council needs to continually grow to help meet growing needs.

Talk to your pastor.

A council that doesn't work with a pastor will struggle. Meet with him regularly. Talk about membership growth and ask him how you can work together. Ask if you can conduct membership drives at the church. Then ask if he will invite men he feels would be a good fit to join your council. Then ask what the council can do for him.

GENERAL RECRUITING BEST PRACTICES

Challenge your members.

One of the most effective ways to recruit is a personal invite from a Knight. Challenge each of your members to bring in one new Knight this fraternal year. Everyone knows someone who should join our Order.

Schedule church drives.

Delta Church Drive Program is helping councils bring in a minimum of three new members per drive. If you're not familiar with the program, reach out to us at the email address below. We'll give you the training and the materials you need.

GENERAL RECRUITING BEST PRACTICES

Set clear expectations on promoting membership.

Every fish fry, every pancake breakfast, every charitable activity, every event that draws a crowd is an opportunity to ask a man to join. These events are concrete proof of your council's good works. Talk about membership at every event in the next year. Use our Online Prospect Form. It's simple and we'll take care of all the setup for you. Send us an email and we'll help you get started.

Step outside of your comfort zone.

We hear a lot of stories from men who waited decades for someone to ask them to join the Knights. All it took was a personal invite. Go beyond your everyday circle. Talk with parishioners at Mass. Be visible. Reach out to the young and old. Reach out to all ministries and ethnic groups in your parish.

Our growth in membership is but one step along the way. There are 1.8 million member of the Knights of Columbus. Why are so many so hesitant to join the Guild?

 The Online Membership system was introduced in 2018 in an effort to make joining the Order easier and less time consuming for the candidates in today's fast paced world.

 I am convinced that it is a valuable and indispensable tool for getting new members to join.

Statistics

- FY 2018 2019 68 new members initiated
- FY 2019 2020 53 new members initiated
- FY 2020 2021 228 new members initiated
- FY 2021 2022 196 new members initiated with 128 members, 65%, transferring to a local council.
- FY 2022 6/28/2023 249 new members initiated with 157 members, 63%, transferring to a local council.

- Current Fraternal Year, as of 10/4/2023, 93 new members initiated with 62 members, 67% transferring to a local council.
- Overall intake of Online Members since inception, 922 with 623, 68%, converted to councils.
- All new members will not transfer to a local council, but we must give them the opportunity and respect their decision.

- I have a personal goal of 90% of new online members transferring to local councils. That may be aggressive but I think it is achievable.
- Without reaching out and transferring these men we are missing an excellent opportunity to grow our councils' membership, and provide more resources to increase the performance of the good works that we all do throughout our parishes, our state, our nation, and our world.

How it works

- A candidate joins online at <u>www.kofc.org/joinus</u> using a computer, a cell phone or a tablet.
- He receives free dues for one year, still advertised as a limited time offer, by using the promo code "BlessedMcGivney" during the registration process.
- Upon joining the Order, the new member counts toward the new member goal of the Alabama State Council.
- The new online member can remain an online member for life, if he prefers, or he can transfer to a local council after participating in a combined ceremonial exemplification.

- Once the new online member has participated in the combined ceremonial, he may transfer to a local council through the normal process, by making application, going through the council's admission committee process, and being accepted and transferred into the council.
- Once he is transferred to a council, he counts as a new member toward the council's new member goal and he can participate in the good works of the council and enjoy the experience of a lifetime.



Potential Setbacks To Be Aware Of

- The online join process requires that the applicant have an active working email address. He will receive a verification email and will have a designated time, I believe it is 24 hours, to respond. If he does not respond, the process is terminated and must be started over if he still wants to join.
- The staff at Supreme is looking into changing to a text message verification system in an effort to make this process easier for the candidates, primarily because some do not have email.
 - I am not sure where that effort stands.

Advantages

- The process is quick and easy for the busy young candidates living in today's world.
- It is available on a platform that most potential members are familiar with, phone, tablet, computer.
- It makes them members, with no wait for a degree ceremony to be scheduled, and they begin to receive information from Supreme to help them become more familiar with the Knights of Columbus while they await admission committee approval, view or attend the combined ceremonial, and are transferred, if that is their desire.

Advantages

- Remember that anyone, including family members of the new member, can view the combined ceremony at any time and it is not necessary to await admission committee approval to get this step done.
- If they have viewed the ceremony when they are approved by the Committee, they can immediately be transferred to a council.

Going forward:

 New officers should have access to Officers Online now. Be sure to check your Prospect Tab on a regular basis for e-members assigned to your council. Many of you have a great start on your new member goals for the year. Membership is one of the hardest goals we have to achieve to qualify for Star Council Status each year.

 If you have a man on your Prospect Tab, contact him and see if you can get him transferred into your council.

Going forward:

- If something prevents a member from being transferred into your council, please reject them.
 - There is nothing wrong with rejecting them, that is the reason for this option in the system, and by doing so, you will reduce the clutter in the system.
 - When rejecting a candidate, you will be asked to choose a reason from three choices. Choose the one that best fits your situation and go forward.
 - You are not kicking them out of the Knights of Columbus, you are helping to keep the system manageable.

In closing:

- ★ 4 Councils are at 100% or better on their new member goal for Fraternal Year 2023-2024 already.
- ★ 2 District Deputies are at 100% or better on their new member goal for Fraternal Year 2023-2024.
- ★ One new council has been instituted for Fraternal Year 2023-2024 in Russellville, Council 18293.
- ★ Great start on the year from my perspective and thanks to all who have worked hard to make that happen.
