Supreme Rep Remarks JC Reiher, RGD

Good afternoon, best part of my job. Last year the order as a whole had a record year, just shy of 92K new members. AL had a great year over 130% of membership. Recognize Danny Garcia and Joe Flaherty with Pinnacle trophy. Danny noted this is a culmination of everyone's efforts last year, congratulations to all, can't do it without everyone's help. Thanks for all you do. June 30 is end of fraternal year. Not a destination, it's a checkpoint where we need to finish strong. Opportunity to motivate councils to STAR. Start now, gives us most time to get there. Focus on FBE, Safe Environment and Forms, common tripping points. Two virtual FBE's upcoming end of January and early Feb (Spanish). Perfect opportunities. If you are on track for STAR, strive for double STAR. Attach a membership component to every activity, and programs (active work, not just a table with flyers). Get a high energy guy to focus on it. Have programs (are they enticing, good for members and membership). If they are not meaningful, need to change things up. Always extend a personal invitation to non-members and teach your councils to do that. Hold at least 1 membership drive per district per month. GK's, please lend your commitment to this. Wish GK's great success. Fishers of Men (Matt 4:19). Research indicates 7 mill catholic men who would join if asked. Fishers of Men lies at the heart of Knights of Columbus. ID a new guy, tell your story, what you get out of your membership, invite them to join. Use your phone and the online form to sign him up, use the Blessed McGivney code to get him a free year to try us out. Encourage members of the council to do the same. Make sure they confirm their e-mail to complete the online process. Lots of materials on the website to help you. Work with your field agent, they are professional recruiters. The heart of a knight is in every catholic man, you just need to ask. Thanks for your dedication and commitment and your presence today.

### State Deputy remarks, Bill Mores, SD

Hard to believe it's been over 6 months already, amazed at what you are doing, thank you for that. Been a pretty good year so far, not great. Slightly behind in a few things. Membership, STAR and Faith formation. We have 2 of our 3 Holy hours, we'll have another at convention, we'll make that. 17 Star councils is the goal, that's a focal point. Membership is slightly behind.



Need 429 currently at 227 as of this meeting. Missed a goal reduction in Q2. Can still get more reductions if we hit 75% by end of Q3 (need 95). Showed the pledge chain from kickoff meeting, still counting you. Ask for help if you need it. We want to hit pinnacle again this year if we can.

### General Agent remarks, John Stice, GA

Good afternoon. Pointed out we have 4 past SD's at front, shows their dedication to the Order. Happy to have chosen AL as his state. Agency has a membership goal of 144, each agent has a goal of 12. The agency contacts every new member, welcomes them to the order and lets them know about the agency and what is available. Please encourage the new members to hear what the organization offers and the great benefits available to them. We align our investments with our faith. Working on getting the online review of investments working. There is a Hispanic agent in MS who will be coming to help in AL in near future.

#### ASK AL KC remarks, Margaret Lagasse, President

# Evangelization, Fait & Formation remarks, Mike Schultz, EFFD

We couldn't be successful without the ladies, thanks to them, please acknowledge them. Recognized 764 member Dan Seleski who is instrumental in Silver Rose, spoke about the Guadalupanas, those ladies were instrumental in making that program a huge success. Focus on faith, central to that is God's word, and the true presence. Too many Catholics do not believe in the true presence in the eucharist. Opened with prayer. Cor is Latin for Heart. Introduced his family, gave background, was guy that was chased. He and his wife both run Hispanic ministry at home parish. Lost his son 2-1/2 years ago. Brought him closer to God. Shared his story, example of testifying. This is part of how COR works. Had fallen from faith earlier in life, was brought back to faith due to witness of a protestant group years ago, so has a relationship with them. Ignorance of scripture is ignorance of Christ. God's word is central to COR. COR - Slides cover program. Evangelization and faith formation key to Fr McGivney's vision. COR is how to run programs in EFF, not a specific program in and of itself. 18 – 35 year olds, 60% indicate participation in faith related groups outside Mass. Into the Breach series is great. 81% of views on YouTube are young adults 18-35. Signs that there is a movement of people back to the church. That Man is You weekly small groups. Mirrors COR. Knights must be first in Faith as in Charity. Bring men to Christ the same way Jesus brought men to himself. Invitation, Friendship, Brotherhood, Shared Mission. COR is Christ centered brotherhood, Prayer, Formation, Fraternity. Open to all men, not just Knights. In service to Pastor, requires his permission. Not meant to compete with other men's ministries, but to strengthen and support them. Simple structure, 60 – 90 minute events. COR is on kofc.org. Don't get too wrapped up in policy. We are our brother's keeper. There is a startup guide. Keep it simple and start.



### Membership remarks, Joe Flaherty, MD, PSD, DM

Handed out shirts from past incentives. Recognizes work that ultimately leads to Pinnacle. Good afternoon, thanks to all. Membership number at 52.9% currently, we're off our mark. Proud we're working hard, need to get back after it. 3<sup>rd</sup> in our division, want to be #1. Reviewed numbers and incentives (see slides). Become Fishers of Men. Showed video. Not about hitting a number or getting an award, it's about doing more of our mission. It's about obligation. Every catholic man deserves what we have as Knights. Recruiting is not hard. Just ask. That's why 47% join. Most asked why they haven't joined say because no one asked me. Asked Randy Duffy to share his tips.

Works with the church office to get names and numbers of new members of the parish, then invites them to a meeting. Ask, Ask, Ask. Give new members of the church from RCIA a week or two after joining church, then approach them.

Please copy Joe when a new member joins so we can get you your incentives.

Sitting at 230 members right now, golden number is 90 new members by 31 March. Gets our reduction and ½ way to COH. Pinnacle, kick butt all over the place. Stressed STAR council, reviewed requirements. Reviewed incentives (see slides). Reviewed online membership.


